

MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

To all Members:

The keys have been changed and a new year has begun. I would like to take this time to remind everyone of your responsibilities when using the indoor range. Please take a moment and go over the list to make sure we are all doing our part in caring for the range.

- SIGN IN - Everyone must sign in before shooting.
- PAY: Pay the appropriate fee for your use and put money in score box if no one is available to collect.
- PRACTICE FEES INCLUDE ONE TARGET - please feel free to use a used target if available, be cost efficient when possible.
- SHOOTING LEAGUE SCORE - You MUST move your target after shooting thirty (30) arrows. If shooting the single spot, consider moving more often. Let's keep our target backs in good shape as long as possible.
- DON'T LEAVE BOW CASES ON TABLES - After setting up your bow, place all bow cases on shelves provided. Don't be rude.
- OBEY THE RULES ON THE SIGN - If you have to ask what sign, then you have never read it and need to, it's by the door on the wall, check it out.
- IF YOU BRING A FRIEND - they too must sign in and pay. If they come often, more than three times, ask them to join. Support your club. Remember, this is a private club, don't abuse your privileges.
- CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF - Make sure you remove targets, these can be saved on shelf by office door, or throw away if not usable. Throw away your cans and any trash you have from food, etc. This is your club, keep it nice. Don't make the next user have to clean your mess.
- TURN OFF ALL LIGHTS - Don't forget the target lights up front.
- LOCK THE DOORS - Don't assume they lock, check them before driving away.
- YOUTH, 17 & UNDER, MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT - Don't give your key to your son or daughter to use if they are too young and you are not going to accompany them. This is for the club's liability, we need to remain safe.
- BE POLITE AND HELPFUL TO EVERYONE - If you come to a shooting event, or just to practice and non-members are present, be helpful and set a good example for the club, this might be a prospective member. Always promote new memberships. We want to grow.

This is a short list; use common sense and all will be well. If a problem should arise, please call an officer for advice. The officer list with phone numbers will be posted on the back of the office door.
